In February 1998, a vigil was organized, to protest the US military actions and sanctions waged against Iraq since 1990. For 10 years participants continue to stand each and every Friday protesting the humanitarian crises caused by U.S. sanctions and bombings, and now the invasion and occupation of Iraq, which has resulted in misery, death, and torture. Come to the vigil on Feb 15th to mark the 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary of this action and the 6<sup>th</sup> Month of the Iraq War Moratorium.
