Performers and speakers should provide a brief 'Bio' at check-in to be used by the MC's when you are introduced. Please provide as much notice as possible of special needs, including assistance with moving any equipment. Tabling space will be available to performers for sales of recorded material and to speakers for relevant literature distribution. There will be a Green Room near the main stage for you convenience. Ask for more information when you register.
